GEMS Education parents who successfully applied for the COVID-19 Relief Package have to date received discounts on the current term's fees ranging from 25 per cent all the way up to 100 per cent in cases of extreme hardship. Our school has dished out relief packages to 320 families so far!

Literacy




General Awareness
