

GUIS Graduation/Awards/Commendations Policy

Commendation certificates are awarded in order to motivate and encourage children's performance in both Scholastic and Non-Scholastic areas. We believe that all children are capable of progress and achievement. These certificates will not only recognize and reward individual achievement and progress but will also create self-awareness in children as well as celebrate success in all areas.

Commendation Certificates in the Scholastic areas will be on the basis of two groups of subjects and on the criteria as given below.

Group A: Arabic, Islamic Education/Moral Education, UAE Social Studies (Grades 4-9)

Group B: English, II Language, Mathematics, EVS/ Science, Social Studies (Grade 5-10), Grade 11/12: 5 CBSE core subjects.

Sheikha Fatima Bint Mubarak Award for Excellence:

The award highlights Her Highness Sheikha Fatima Bint Mubarak's role as the Mother of the Nation and her vision to celebrate and support women's achievements and self-determination.

The award celebrates female students who have proven themselves as global citizens, exhibited outstanding leadership qualities, exceptional academic achievements and commitment towards the communities in which they live.

The individual award winners become ambassadors for both the schools and GEMS. The students undertake media interviews and talk to other students about their experience in order to inspire others to emulate their achievement. The award increases both the confidence and character of these young women who find themselves being celebrated in a way they had never thought of before.

Each year, the award winners receive a scholarship for one whole year's tuition at their GEMS School, as well as a memento commemorating the achievements of young girls of the GEMS schools.
